Of the more than 50,000 high scorers nationwide, about 16,000 will be named National Merit Program Semifinalists, representing the top scorers in each state, and approximately 34,000 others will be commended for their performance on the PSAT/NMSQT. Semifinalists and Commended Students in the 2014 National Merit Program will learn of their standing in September when we send you notification and ask you to inform your students. Semifinalists will be the only students who will have an opportunity to continue in the competition for about 8,300 National Merit Scholarships to be offered in 2014. Details about the competition and levels of program recognition are described in the *Guide to the National Merit Scholarship Program* that was mailed to you last fall.

We are genuinely grateful for your assistance. The cooperation and encouragement of high school principals and counselors are essential to NMSC's efforts to recognize and honor the academically talented students of the United States.
